Madame Tussauds Budapest is an Access4you location, so you can find detailed and reliable accessibility information about the exhibition in the Access4you database, which helps you prepare for the visit.

The attraction provides a barrier-free environment for wheelchair users, the elderly, people with limited mobility, as well as visually impaired guests and visitors arriving with assistance dogs.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Madame Tussauds Budapest is located in the city center close to Vörösmarty Square. The entrance to Madame Tussauds Budapest is located at the corner of the building, at the intersection of Dorottya utca and Wekerle Sándor utca. The entire attraction is located on the ground floor so you don't have to use stairs here. The small level differences between some rooms are bridged with ramps. The staff at the ticket office and in the entire area of the exhibition continuously help with orientation and the use of interactive tools.

We would like to draw your attention to the fact that the intensity of the lights, the visual effects and stronger sound effects in some rooms may be disturbing for some guests and for small children.

Madame Tussauds Budapest is committed to making the attraction as inclusive as possible to all guests. As such, we are happy to help guests who are unable to queue for long periods of time to access the attraction quicker if necessary. For this please contact our staff.

The attraction is fully air-conditioned and has a buffet.

You can find 2 accessible toilets in the site.

TRAVEL TO MADAME TUSSAUDS BUDAPEST

Metro



The closest metro station that is fully accessible from the platform to the street is Deák Square station, which is 550 m from the attraction.

The nearest metro station to Madame Tussauds Budapest is Vörösmarty Square station, which is 200 m from the attraction.

Bus



The nearest bus stop is just outside of the building at Dorottya Street.

Tram



You can arrive by tram too, the closest stop is at Eötvös Square.

PARKING



Please note that the museum does not have an own parking lot.

FIRST AID
